**Studio Ballet Dress Code-Black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers with hair in a neat bun and level-appropriate bow or headband. Pink or black ballet sweaters are allowed. Levels III-V only may wear black or level appropriate colored skirts. Level V may wear any color or patterned skirts. Levels III-V may wear leg warmers for barre only. No jewelry except for stud earrings. No sweatshirts, sweats, or athletic attire allowed.**

**Center Stage Dance Dress Code-Dance wear (leotard/tights/dance top/leggings, dance shorts, etc...) and appropriate dance shoes are to be worn to all classes with hair pulled back in a neat bun or ponytail. No street clothes allowed. No jewelry except for stud earrings. Pre-ballet/creative movement/tap students (ages 3-4) are to wear a pink leotard (attached skirts ok) with pink tights. Hip hop students may wear casual, easy to move in attire such as shorts, sweats, and t-shirts with socks or dance sneakers. Acro students go barefoot & wear a gymnastics leotard, biketard, or ballet leotard. Bike shorts are ok over leotard. Hair must be neatly pulled back in a ponytail, braid, bun, etc...**
